3. AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: (Note: The same choir may not appear at consecutive conventions.)

- Include a high-quality cassette tape, CD, or digital recording which includes at least THREE selections, not to exceed 25 minutes total playing time, (or 12 minutes, if selected above) representing the choir which would perform at the **2011 WCDA State Convention**.
- The recording should include complete works, unless there are several movements. Include performances of the choir from the 2009-2010 school year (season) and samples of representative printed programs from 2 prior years.
- DO NOT put identifying marks on the recording itself, but DO place a label with name of director and choir on the case or envelope. Include a separate sheet listing only the contents of the audition recording—title of song and composer/arranger.

- The recordings will be heard by a team of WCDA members from various areas of choral directing, and each will remain anonymous to the listeners. All audition materials will become the property of WCDA.
- It is understood that choirs invited to perform at the **2011 WCDA State Convention** will be responsible for all financial expenses including transportation, housing, music, and any meals associated with this event.
- WCDA will provide a piano, risers, podium, music stands, and a microphone at the performance site for performing groups.

Director must be a member of WCDA to apply, and must have held present conducting position for two or more years.
